This dance film features eight women embodying a past moment of violence, engaging with the nuance of their personal narrative, and reclaiming empowerment with their own physicality. Featuring poetry by Luke Ryan, the film displays the journey from loss of power into a reimagined future.

Wrongful: a screen dance (2020)

This screen dance aims to tell the stories of wrongfully incarcerated individuals through text and embodied interpretations of individual experiences. The focus of the work is hope and reconciliation of the past self with future possibilities. I recognize that though we are telling these particular stories because they include moments of incarceration, each character in the piece experienced a past and has a future to look forward to. Each person has hopes, dreams, and goals. Within that recognition, we also realize that spending time incarcerated has a significant impact on one's life, and those experiences will color their futures. *Wrongful* is an exploration of the past, present, and future of incarcerated bodies through text, movement, and camera edits.
